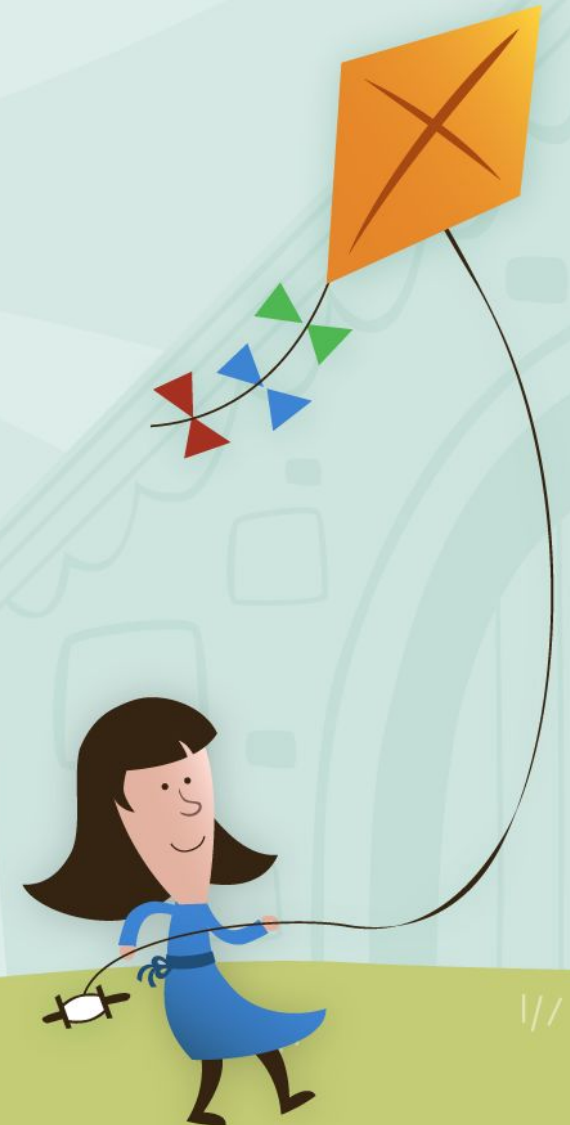


Saint Paul's Primary School Child Friendly Child Safety Policy
