Taking you on a journey of Australia's First Nation Dreamtime through an interactive and vibrant experience, Majeda Beatty presents both Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island cultures as well as sharing her perspective on being an Indigenous millennial woman. She believes in the importance of cultural pride and carrying on past traditions as well as moving forward in a modern world.



The performance will allow us to be immersed through song, dance, stories and language. The flags will be discussed and Majeda will present and demonstrate various instruments, artifacts and costumes specific to each culture as well as the importance of ochre and the significance of the body paint designs in aboriginal culture.

HELLO FROM MR FARACI THE SCHOOL COUNSELLOR



Dear Families,

This year I continue my role at St Paul's working as the school counsellor.

Counselling is a passion of mine and I am blessed to have the opportunity to work in this field at St Paul's.

As a school counsellor, my job is to talk to the children when they have a problem that they would like help with. Sometimes these problems are big and I speak with these children a few times over a school term. Sometimes, these problems are small and children only speak with me once. Examples of things I might talk to children about include problems at home, fights with friends and feeling angry, sad or worried at school.

As part of my work, I also visit classrooms and explore with children some concepts that help them problem solve, develop resilience tools and techniques, build relationships and feel good about their school experiences. This term, I worked with the children on the concepts of "all feelings are okay" and building relationships with classmates and teachers.

I would be more than happy for families to telephone the school should you have any further questions or if you would like your child to speak with me. Please note that I work at St Paul's on Mondays and Tuesdays.

I look forward to being of service this year and I welcome any student or family member to reach out if I can be of help.


