CDF PAY FOR ST PAUL'S - GOING CASH FREE

Dear Parents,

St. Paul's together with the Parents & Friends is introducing a new system for cash payment of special lunch days, fundraisers and other children's events. St Paul's have teamed up with Catholic Development Fund Melbourne (CDF) to bring you the online payment platform. This will allow you to log onto a secure and safe store to eliminate cash.

The benefits of our school going cash-free with CDFpay are:

- Anytime, any device: order and pay for lunches from your mobile, tablet or computer at any time:
- Fast & easy payments: it allows credit card or bank transfer payments;
- Reduced administration: counting and handling cash.

As a part of this transition process, we ask every parent to log on and set up an account. From 12 June we will no longer be accepting cash orders. Please ensure that your account is ready to go for the next school event where payment is required.

- You are now ready to place orders using CDFpay.








GRADE 3/4 GOD'S PRESENCE IN NATURE



REMINDERS!


OVERDUE BOOKS
