We have been working very hard over the past few weeks; learning our lines and practicing our songs to make sure we are prepared.

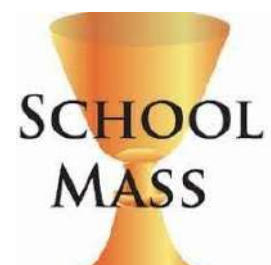

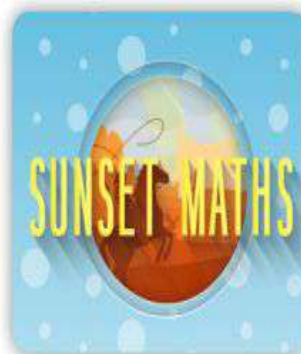


Our teachers use Essential Assessment to assess each child's development. Once this is established children have access to a variety of [My Numeracy](#) learning tasks where they earn stars to show mastery of concepts, in order to move to the next level in their learning.

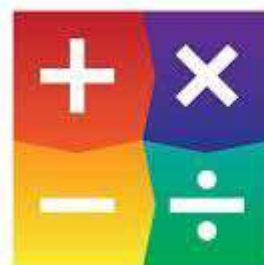
This program also gives them access to [Sunset Maths](#), which is a rapid recall activity to build up automatic response in the 4 processes (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Sunset Maths

Sunset Maths is an application aimed at developing the student's mental maths skills. This is available through the games icon and sets up based upon the student's pre-assessment results. The student will work through curriculum aligned content to develop their knowledge in each operator in alignment with their learning.



Math Facts: We definitely want to keep children's math facts fluent, even over holiday break. So play mental math-counting games in the car, have a math family game or use Sunset Maths on Essential Assessment.

Child Care Subsidy

Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrelink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibility. Each session is calculated using the full service operational hours, not the hours attended by the child.

Unexpected changes to activities

In the unlikely event that an activity is unable to run, an alternative activity will be provided.

Activities and times are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather or provider availability. If an alternative cannot be sourced we will update your invoice to reflect this.

Medical Management Plan & Medication

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- ☐ A completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo
- ☐ Necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication or medication not be supplied.
